What is Strathmore Regional Victim Services?

SRVSS is a Not-For-Profit organization that provides 24hr Crisis Response to victims of crime and tragedy within the communities and areas served by the Strathmore, Chestermere, Langdon and Gleichen RCMP. We also assist individuals by providing victim's rights, emotional support, referral to resources and information on the Criminal Justice System. We also provide court support if needed.

What is a Volunteer Advocate?

A Volunteer Advocate is a trained compassionate individual who volunteers to provide crisis intervention to victims of crime and traumatic events under the guidance of our dedicated staff.

Requirements:

You must be at minimum 18 years of age, have a vehicle and valid driver's license.

You must be an excellent communicator and able to converse effectively in English.

You must be able to commit to a minimum of 60 on call hours per month.

You must be able to pass an RCMP Enhanced Security Clearance and Interview Process

Once accepted you must complete approximately 80 hours online eLearning and able to attend regularly scheduled team meetings
